

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo, Cebu City

as of 02 June 2025, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2025, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo, Cebu City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the incident at around 12:30 PM and had the fire extinguished by 1:52 PM. Due to the incident, several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing 330 individuals in the area.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cebu City for any updates and requests for resource augmentation to support the affected individuals.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **92 families** or **330 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo**, **Cebu City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **92 families** or **330 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Acacia Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **50** houses were damaged; of which, **49** are **totally damaged** and **one (1) Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo, Cebu City** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Kinasang-an Pardo, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
