

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Labogon, Mandaue City as of 13 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 June 2025, a fire broke out in Brgy. Labogon, Mandaue City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene at around 3:30 PM and extinguished the fire by 4:59 PM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area.

A total of **55 families** or **256 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labogon, Mandaue City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **55 families** or **256 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Labogon Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Labogon, Mandaue City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **55 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Labogon, Mandaue City** (see Annex C).
