I. Situation Overview

On 27 May 2025 at around 2:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Galgal, Brgy. Lenneng, Kabugao, Apayao.

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Lenneng, Kabugao, Apayao** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱14,428.31** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
