I. Situation Overview

On 11 June 2025 at around 2:34 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Masical, Santo Niño (Faire), Cagayan.

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Masical, Santo Niño (Faire), Cagayan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Masical, Santo Niño (Faire), Cagayan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,827.28** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
