

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte as of 18 June 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 May 2025 at around 10:28 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 10:49 AM.

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte** (see Annex A).

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,435.10** worth of assistance was by **DSWD** provided to the affected family (see Annex D).
