

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra

as of 16 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 May 2025 at around 5:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Borbon St., corner Rizal St., Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 AM.

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in **Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱48,864.25** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱28,864.25** from **DSWD** and **₱20,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
