I. Situation Overview

On 30 May 2025 at around 5:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Borbon St., corner Rizal St., Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Zone 6 Pob. (Sinapangan), Bangued, Abra (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}48,864.25\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}28,864.25\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}20,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
