

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato

as of 14 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 June at around 4:00 AM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to prevailing easterlies. These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms. Later that day at around 6:00 AM, a flash flood caused by heavy rains associated with the easterlies occurred in Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato.

A total of 489 families or 2,445 persons are affected in Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato (see Annex A).
