

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incidents in Zamboanga City

as of 07 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 07 June 2025 at around 4AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms due to Southwest Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains.

On the same day at around 11:40 AM, several barangays in Zamboanga City experienced flooding due to heavy rainfall caused by Southwest Monsoon.

A total of **404 families** or **1,765 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

There are **404 families** or **1,765 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **six (6) evacuation centers** in **Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).
