

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Tagbaros, Maco, Davao de Oro as of 08 June 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 06 June 2025 at around 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rain and thunderstorms caused by Low Pressure Area (LPA) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains in Bicol Region and the rest of Visayas and Mindanao.

On the same day, around 3:00 PM, a landslide caused by LPA occurred in Brgy. Tagbaros, Maco, Davao de Oro, affecting 335 individuals.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XI, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Maco, Davao de Oro, for any updates and requests for resource augmentation to support the affected individuals.
