

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Soil Erosion Incidents in Brgy. Virac, Itogon, Benguet

as of 25 June 2025, 6PM

# I. Situation Overview

On 22 June 2025, two (2) soil erosion incidents occurred at Camps 3 South and 5 in Sitio Acupan, Brgy. Virac, Itogon, Benguet, due to persistent localized thunderstorms experienced in the area. These conditions have resulted in the displacement of 80 individuals residing in the affected areas and caused damage to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office Cordillera Administrative Region (FO CAR), together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Itogon, Benguet, provided relief and financial assistance (FA) to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **44 families** or **80 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Virac**, **Itogon**, **Benguet** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

# **Inside Evacuation Center**

There is one (1) family or four (4) persons currently taking temporary shelter in Acupan Elementary School in Brgy. Virac, Itogon, Benguet (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 18 houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and 17 are partially damaged in Brgy. Virac, Itogon, Benguet (see Annex D).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱79,321.15 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families, of which, ₱70,921.15 from DSWD and ₱8,400.00 from the LGU (see Annex E).


