

DSWD DROMIC Report #10 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon and Low Pressure Area (LPA) as of 13 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 05 June 2025 at around 4:00 PM, cloudy skies with scattered rain and thunderstorms caused by the Trough of Low Pressure Area (LPA) might have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to heavy rains in the rest of Visayas and Mindanao. On the same day, some low-lying barangays in Aleosan, North Cotabato experienced a flash flood due to heavy rains brought by the trough of LPA.

On 06 June 2025 at around 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms caused by the Southwest Monsoon might have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Luzon. On the same day at around 3:00 PM, a flash flood occurred in several barangays in San Jose Del Monte, Bulacan. Further, a landslide caused by LPA also occurred in Brgy. Tagbaros, Maco, Davao de Oro.

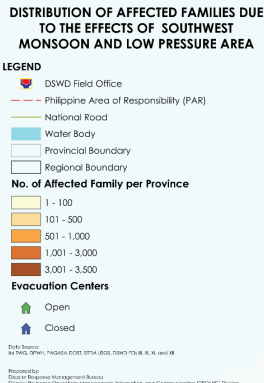
On 07 June 2025 at around 11:40 AM, several barangays in Zamboanga City experienced flooding due to heavy rainfall caused by Southwest Monsoon and LPA.

On 12 June 2025, a flooding incident occurred in the Municipality of Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental due to heavy rainfall caused by Southwest Monsoon and LPA.

A total of **4,889 families** or **16,767 persons** are affected in **45 barangays** in **Regions III, IX, XI**, and **XII** (see Annex A).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱156.31 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) available at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱12 million available at DSWD FOs III, IX, XI, and XII.
- ₱35.02 million available in other DSWD FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Southwest Monsoon and LPA through inter-FO augmentation.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 730,726 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 399,694 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 331,032 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 714,486 FFPs available at DSWD FOs III, IX, XI, and XII.
- 1,561,727 FFPs available in other DSWD FOs, which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Southwest Monsoon and LPA through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱880.25 million worth of other FNIs available at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
