

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. San Vicente, Esperanza, Agusan del Sur

as of 01 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 December 2024, an armed conflict occurred between armed groups in Brgy. San Vicente, Esperanza, Agusan del Sur. The ongoing threats and security concerns affected families and individuals in the Higaonon community, displacing them as they fled to safer ground in another barangay.

On 24 - 31 May 2025, the LGU of Esperanza, through its Tribal Affairs Office, carried out a coordinated effort to facilitate the safe relocation of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 33 families or 120 persons are affected in Brgy. San Vicente, Esperanza, Agusan del Sur (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are one (1) family or five (5) persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Poblacion Evacuation Center in Brgy. Poblacion, Esperanza, Agusan del Sur (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **115 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 33 families or 120 persons displaced in Brgy. San Vicente, Esperanza, Agusan del Sur (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}220,120.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}182,820.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}37,300.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
