



### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **359 families** or **1,366 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **8 evacuation centers** in **Regions III** and **IX** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **206 families** or **825 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **565 families** or **2,191 persons** still displaced in **Regions III** and **IX** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **65 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Regions III** and **IX** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱285,210.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱250,965.00** from **DSWD** and **₱34,245.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
