

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City as of 02 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 June 2025 at around 12:01 PM, a fire broke out at Globo De Oro St., Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the incident and had the fire extinguished by 6:25 PM. Several residential structures were completely destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area. No casualties were reported.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **513 families** or **1,553 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **513 families** or **1,553 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at a campsite along the street of Brgy. 384 in **Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **163 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 384, Quiapo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,853,315.60** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
