I. Situation Overview

On 23 May 2025 at around 10:28 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 10:49 AM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion District V, Barugo, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P18,435.10** worth of assistance was by **DSWD** provided to the affected family (see Annex D).
