

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato

as of 17 June 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 June at around 4:00 AM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to prevailing easterlies. These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms. Later that day at around 6:00 AM, a flash flood caused by heavy rains associated with the easterlies occurred in Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **489 families** or **2,445 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bulucaon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **147 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Bulucaon Gym in Pigkawayan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱304,158.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
