

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Tornado Incident in Lambunao, Iloilo

as of 19 June 2025. 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 June 2025, at around 3:00 PM, a tornado incident was experienced in several barangays in Lambunao, Iloilo, that caused damage to properties.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Lambunao, Iloilo, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **225 families** or **867 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **Lambunao**, **Iloilo** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **225 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Lambunao**, **Iloilo** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,009,199.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱844,274.00 from DSWD and ₱164,925.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
