

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Davao Region

as of 16 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 12 June 2025 at around 4:00 PM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms. These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On 13 June 2025 at around 3:00 AM, several barangays in Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental experienced flash floods and landslides due to intense rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

On the same day, due to intense rains brought by localized thunderstorms, a flooding incident was experienced in the municipality of Malalag, Davao del Sur. Further, the municipality of Jose Abad Santos in Davao Occidental also experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous intense rainfall.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **4,173 families** or **16,430 persons** are affected in **18 barangays** in the **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
 There are 132 families or 447 persons currently taking temporary shelter in five
 (5) evacuation centers in Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center
 One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population There are 133 families or 452 persons still displaced in Davao Region (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20** houses were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **10** are **partially damaged** in **Davao Region** (see Annex E).
