

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **393 families** or **1,710 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Regions III and IX** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **165 families** or **620 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **558 families** or **2,330 persons** still displaced in **Regions III and IX** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **65 houses** were **partially damaged** in **Regions III and IX** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱502,570.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱468,325.00** from **DSWD** and **₱34,245.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
