

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City as of 12 June 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 June 2025 at around 10:14 AM, a fire broke out at Jose Carlo Agudo St., Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 1:28 PM. Several structures were destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area. No casualties were reported, except for three residents who suffered from hyperventilation and lacerations.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **148 families** or **517 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **84 families** or **323 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **86 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱219,292.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
