

# DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms and Easterlies in Davao Region

as of 18 June 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 12 June 2025 at around 4:00 PM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms. These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On 13 June 2025 at around 3:00 AM, several barangays in Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental experienced flash floods and landslides due to intense rains brought by localized thunderstorms.

On the same day, due to intense rains brought by localized thunderstorms, a flooding incident was experienced in the municipality of Malalag, Davao del Sur. Further, the municipality of Jose Abad Santos in Davao Occidental also experienced flooding and landslides due to continuous intense rainfall.

On 17 June 2025, the municipality of Santo Tomas, Davao del Norte experienced flooding due to continuous heavy rainfall caused by Easterlies.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **4,315 families** or **16,989 persons** are affected in **24 barangays** in **Davao Region** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 173 families or 664 persons currently taking temporary shelter in nine (9) evacuation centers in Davao Region (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **33 families** or **84 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **206 families** or **748 persons** still displaced in **Davao Region** (see Annex F).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **10** are **partially damaged** in **Davao Region** (see Annex G).



### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}3,565,954.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}3,554,434.00\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}11,520.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex H).
