

DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City as of 01 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 June 2025 at around 10:14 AM, a fire broke out at Jose Carlo Agudo St., Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and extinguished the fire by 1:28 PM. Several residential structures were destroyed, displacing numerous residents in the area. No casualties were reported, except for three (3) residents who suffered from hyperventilation and lacerations.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region X, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **148 families** or **517 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **84 families** or **323 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **covered court** in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **86 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** were **totally damaged** and **four (4)** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 24, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,587,974.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱1,368,682.00** from **DSWD** and **₱219,292.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex F).
