

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in San Dionisio, Iloilo

11 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 June 2025, at around 3:00 PM, continuous heavy rainfall due to localized thunderstorms caused flooding to low-lying barangays of San Dionisio, Iloilo.

In response to these incidents, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VI, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **173 families** or **783 persons** were affected in **San Dionisio, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **173 families** or **783 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱107,606.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
