

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sta. Rosa, Pilar, Bataan

30 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 January 2025 at around 8:15 PM, a fire broke out in Brgy. Sta. Rosa, Pilar, Bataan. The fire destroyed some residential structures, affecting a few families residing in the area. No injuries or casualties were reported.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region III, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pilar, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **seven (7) families** or **53 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Sta. Rosa, Pilar, Bataan** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) were totally damaged and two (2) were partially damaged in Brgy. Sta. Rosa, Pilar, Bataan (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P81,200.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P56,000.00** from **DSWD** and **P25,200.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex C).
