### I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2025 at around 4:50 PM, a strong wind incident occurred in Brgy. San Angel, San Jose de Buenavista, Antique.

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. San Angel, San Jose, Antique** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,088.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
