





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident at Baguio City Public Market in Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop, Baguio City

28 June 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 December 2024 at around 9:32 PM, a fire incident occurred at Baguio City Public Market in Block 4, Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM. Due to the incident, eight (8) individuals were affected.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office Cordillera Administrative Region (FOCAR), in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Baguio City, immediately provided family food packs (FFPs) to the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) stall owners** or **vendors** were affected in **Brgy. Kayang-Hilltop**, **Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P62,112.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected stall owners or vendors; of which, **P14,112.00** from **DSWD** and **P48,000.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex B).
