

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City

28 June 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 April 2025 at around 11:16 PM, a fire broke out at Zone 4, Sitio Tambo, Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City. It was declared a fire out on 28 April 2025 at around 1:09 AM. No injuries or casualties were reported.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region X and in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, provided relief assistance to address the needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37 families** or **87 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **17 families** or **41 persons** sought temporary shelter at **West City Central School** in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **20 families** or **46 persons** remain displaced and are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **37 families** or **87 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** were **totally damaged** and **five (5)** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱394,392.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱318,956.00** from **DSWD** and **₱75,436.00** from the **LGU** (see Annex G).
