

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 20 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 July 2025 at around 10:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the groups of Moner Kamsa and Commander Tong Kasan of Moro Islamic Liberation Front's (MILF) 128 Base Command in Brgy. Bagoenged in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte.

On 11 July 2025, the tension between the two (2) MILF groups escalated further to the neighboring Brgy. Tenonggos of the same municipality resulted in the displacement of 3,545 affected individuals.

At present, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office FO XII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte, for updates and request for relief augmentation for the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **709 families** or **3,545 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

There are **709 families** or **3,545 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).
