

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur

as of 08 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On July 4, 2025, at approximately 11:30 PM, an armed confrontation erupted across Sitios Proper, Samana, Polutan 1, and Polutan 2 in Barangay Linantangan, Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur. The clash involved the group led by Zai Kiaro of the 128th Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and the combined forces of Kumander Gani Adam of the 118th Base Command and Kumander Esmail Salim of the 105th Base Command. The incident resulted in the displacement of several families and individuals from nearby communities.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) XII, is closely coordinating with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur, for updates and potential requests for relief augmentation to address the urgent needs of the affected individuals.

A total of 1,136 families or 5,680 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Shariff Saydona Mustapha, Maguindanao del Sur (see Annex A).
