

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 375, Sta. Cruz, Manila City

as of 08 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2025 at around 1:59 PM, a fire broke out at Tambunting St., Brgy. 375, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The incident was declared a fire out at around 4:38 PM. No casualties were reported.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in the National Capital Region (NCR), promptly engaged in response operations and remains in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.

A total of 133 families or 665 persons are affected in Brgy. 375, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 133 families or 665 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the covered court in Brgy. 378, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 40 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 375, Sta. Cruz, Manila City (see Annex C).
