

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City as of 02 July 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2025 at around 3:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Dagonoy St., Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **45 families** or **145 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **45 families** or **145 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in the tents established along **Dagonoy Street** in **Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **17 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱103,329.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
