I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2025 at around 3:31 PM, a fire incident occurred at Dagonoy St., Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 4:48 PM.

A total of 45 families or 145 persons are affected in Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 45 families or 145 persons currently taking temporary shelter in the tents established along Dagonoy Street in Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 17 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 773, San Andres Bukid, Manila City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P103,329.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
