

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City as of 06 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 July 2025 at around 11:19 AM, a fire incident occurred at Block 27 A&C and Block 29 Baltaw Street, Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:37 PM.

A total of **900 families** or **4,500 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **900 families** or **4500 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in a **permanent evacuation center** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **250 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex C).
