

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Paitan East, Sual, Pangasinan

as of 04 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 May 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Iged, Brgy. Paitan East, Sual, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or two (2) persons are affected in Brgy. Paitan East, Sual, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Paitan East, Sual, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱20,000.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱10,000.00 from DSWD and ₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 707,536 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 319,285 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 388,251 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 72,957 FFPs available at DSWD FO I.
- ₱138.56 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO I warehouses.

b. Other Activities

02 June 2025	 DSWD FO I, through the Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD), provided financial assistance through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) program to the family affected by the fire incident. Additionally, the LGU of Sual, through the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), provided relief and financial assistance to the affected family. DSWD FO I closely coordinated with the LGU of Sual and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.
