## I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2025 at around 8:44 AM, a fire incident occurred at Talon-Talon Loop in Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur.

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **13 families** or **49 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱9,295.00 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex D).
