

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City as of 14 July 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2025 at around 8:44 AM, a fire incident occurred at Talon-Talon Loop in Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur.

A total of **13 families** or **49 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **49 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tugbungan, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱9,295.00** worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex D).
