

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Sampaloc, Manila City as of 02 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 July 2025 at around 12:34 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgys. 439 and 448, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:42 AM.

A total of **196 families** or **689 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **196 families** or **689 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Dela Fuente Street** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **70 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex C).
