

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte

as of 14 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte which affected seven (7) construction workers and three (3) families, and one (1) person remains missing. Meanwhile, rescue operations are currently ongoing.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 10 families or 14 persons are affected in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine** (9) **families or 13 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

Three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P5,778.45** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
