

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Chemical Exposure in Brgy. Pis-anan, Sibalom, Antique

as of 05 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 July 2025 at around 7:20 AM, students from the Pis-anan National High School in Brgy. Pis-anan, Sibalom, Antique experienced difficulty in breathing, chest pains, dizziness, and fainting, due to exposure and inhalation of unknown chemicals. This incident affected several students who were brought to the nearest hospitals to receive proper care and medical attention.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VI, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Sibalom, Antique, immediately provided family food packs (FFPs) to address the needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **378 students** are affected in **Brgy. Pis-anan, Sibalom, Antique** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱198,783.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected individuals; of which, ₱70,908.00 from DSWD and ₱127,875.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex B).
