

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 420, Sampaloc, Manila City

as of 08 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 July 2025 at approximately 12:34 AM, a fire broke out at the intersection of Legarda and Lacson Streets, Brgy. 420, Sampaloc, Manila City. The incident was declared a fire out at 3:10 AM.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in the National Capital Region (NCR), promptly engaged in response operations and remains in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.

A total of 117 families or 415 persons are affected in Brgy. 420, Sampaloc, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 117 families or 415 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the covered court in Brgy. 420, Sampaloc, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **80 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 420**, **Sampaloc**, **Manila City** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 697,859 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which 324,908 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 372,951 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 55,054 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱123.44 million worth of other FNIs available at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

b. Other Activities

07 July 2025	 DSWD FO NCR facilitated the request of the LGU of Manila City for relief augmentation, including FFPs and non-food items.
03 July 2025	 DSWD FO NCR closely coordinated with the LGU of Manila City through the Manila Department of Social Welfare (MDSW) and other concerned offices for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation. DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs.
