

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Pasig City as of 09 July 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 30 June 2025 at around 7:53 PM, a fire incident occurred at Eastbank Road, Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 11:46 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **151 families** or **505 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Pasig City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **151 families** or **505 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Manggahan Covered Court** in **Brgy. Manggahan, Pasig City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **32 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Pasig City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱426,907.31** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
