

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Sampaloc, Manila City as of 04 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 July 2025 at around 12:34 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgys. 439 and 448, Sampaloc, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:42 AM. Due to the incident, 705 individuals were affected and caused significant damage to their houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office National Capital Region (FO NCR), is currently facilitating the request of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City for resource augmentation to address the immediate needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **198 families** or **705 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **198 families** or **705 persons** currently taking temporary shelters at **Dela Fuente Street** of **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **70 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Sampaloc, Manila City** (see Annex C).
