

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan

as of 04 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 May 2025 at around 3:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan that affected the livelihood of vendors and stall occupants.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **308 families** or **355 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion**, **Basista**, **Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **six** (6) **families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, five (5) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}603,070.16\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families and individuals; of which, \$\mathbb{P}419,570.16\$ from \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}183,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
