

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan as of 04 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 May 2025 at around 3:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in the Public Market in Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan that affected the livelihood of vendors and stall occupants.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **308 families** or **355 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Basista, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱603,070.16** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families and individuals; of which, **₱419,570.16** from **DSWD** and **₱183,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
