

# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte

as of 15 July 2025, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a landslide occurred in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte. The incident affected numerous families residing in the area. Search and rescue operations, led by local responders and barangay officials, are ongoing as one person remains missing. Meanwhile, three houses were completely destroyed as a result of the incident.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region VIII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Ricardo, Southern Leyte, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 88 families or 323 persons are affected in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are 11 families or 17 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P69,520.90** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
