

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu

as of 02 July 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 June 2025, a fire broke out in Sitio Mananga II, Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu. The Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) promptly responded to the scene and was able to extinguish the fire by 3:45 PM. Several residential structures were destroyed, displacing numerous families.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region VII, in close coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Talisay City, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **248 families** or **1,000 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **248 families** or **1,000 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 248 houses were damaged; of which, 232 were totally damaged and 16 were partially damaged in Brgy. Tabunok, City of Talisay, Cebu (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱7,490,000.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱3,800,000.00 from DSWD and ₱3,690,000.00 from the LGU (see Annex F).
