

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Flash Flood Incident in Libungan, North Cotabato as of 04 July 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 June at around 4:00 PM, the DOST-PAGASA weather advisory indicated cloudy skies with scattered rains and thunderstorms due to the prevailing Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). These conditions had the potential to cause flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Mindanao and Eastern Visayas.

On the same day, several low-lying barangays in Libungan, North Cotabato experienced a flash flood due to heavy rains caused by ITCZ.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,519 families** or **5,325 persons** are affected in **six (6) barangays** in **Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **eight (8) persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Sinawingan, Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **two (2) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

**One (1) family** or **two (2) persons** are still displaced in **Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **42 houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **41** are **partially damaged** in **Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱885,212.44** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
