

## **DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte**

as of 19 July 2025, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 12 July 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a landslide occurred in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte. The incident affected numerous families residing in the area. Search and rescue operations, led by local responders and barangay officials, are ongoing as one person remains missing. Meanwhile, three (3) houses were completely destroyed as a result of the incident.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) in Region VIII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Ricardo, Southern Leyte, provided relief assistance to address the immediate needs of the affected families.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **178 families** or **562 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **San Ricardo, Southern Leyte** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **47 families** or **163 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **San Ricardo, Southern Leyte** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **105 families** or **370 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **152 families** or **533 persons** still displaced in **San Ricardo, Southern Leyte** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **three (3) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱98,952.90** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
