

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte

as of 21 July 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2025 at around 11:00 PM, a landslide occurred in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte. Due to the incident, 562 individuals were affected and caused significant damage to three (3) houses.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office (FO) VIII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Ricardo, Southern Leyte, immediately provided food and non-food items (FNIs) to address the immediate needs of the affected individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 178 families or 562 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **47 families** or **163 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **San Ricardo**, **Southern Leyte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **105 families** or **370 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **152 families** or **533 persons** still displaced in **San Ricardo**, **Southern Leyte** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Ramon, San Ricardo, Southern Leyte (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱158,952.90 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱128,952.90 from DSWD and ₱30,000.00 from the LGU (see Annex F).
